
ARPA OVERVIEW

- \$350 Billion
- U.S. Treasury's Objectives
 - Support urgent COVID-19 response efforts to continue to decrease spread of the virus and bring pandemic under control;
 - Replace lost public sector revenue to strengthen support for vital public services and help retain jobs;
 - Support immediate economic stabilization for households and businesses; and,
 - Address systemic public health and economic challenges that have contributed to the unequal impact of the pandemic on certain populations.^①




Economic Impacts

Laurel's Objective: To expand and enhance the broadband, qualified infrastructure, and the possibility to partner with others.


TIMELINE



PHASES AND STAGES




PHASES FOR ARPA






APPLICATION PROCESS STAGES








