OUTDOOR POOLS

GENERAL INFORMATION

Laurel Municipal Swimming Pool – 9th and Main Street, (301) 776-7419

A four-pool complex featuring a recreational 4ft, 10 lane, main pool with slide. A three lane lap pool. A deep-water dive well with super slide and diving board. A wading pool for the tots with a water fountain feature. Additionally, the facility offers competitive swim team, and swimming lessons. Relax and enjoy a snack from our full-service concession stand.

Greenview Drive Pool Complex – 14403 Greenview Drive, (301) 604-4042

A two-pool complex featuring a recreational 8 lane, main pool with slide. A wading pool for the tots. Relax and enjoy a snack from our concession stand while eating at our covered picnic pavilion.

Please note the following changes:

- All patrons 5 years old and over must use a face covering while on the pool deck and in common areas. Adults accompanying children ages 2-4 should make a reasonable effort for children to wear a face covering. Face coverings are not required when in the water.
- Individuals and family groups are asked to stay together and maintain six feet of social distancing from other groups at all times.
- Patrons are asked to bring their own chairs or blankets.
- Shared equipment such as kickboards will not be available.
- Restrooms in bath houses will be available, however we encourage patrons to minimize their time in those areas. We kindly ask you to arrive to the pool in your swim attire and shower at home, or utilize our outdoor portable showers for rinsing off.

SUMMER CAMP

Register your child for our modified day camp program which **begins Monday, June 21, 2021**. Day camp is offered to children age 5/6 (your child must be entering 1st grade) – 12 years old. There will be no Teen Camp offered this summer. **Camp meets Monday-Friday 9:00-5:00 p.m. No pre or post camp will be offered and parents must drop-off/pick-up their child at the designated group location.** Face masks for campers and staff are required. Each group will have 8 campers and 2 assigned counselors. Group location and size are subject to change. Campers must provide their own lunches and beverages (refrigeration is not available).

Priority registration for City of Laurel residents begins Monday, March 29, 2021. Registration opens for everyone beginning Monday, April 5 2021. Registration is accepted at the Robert J. DiPietro Community Center.

Securing your Spot

Once camp begins, priority registration for the next week will be given until Tuesday that your camper is registered. We will accept new registrations each Wednesday. To ensure your camper's spot for the following week of camp is secure, we encourage you to register early. You must pay in full to secure your spot.

Non – resident rates will be charged unless Proof of Residency is provided!

POOL INFO & PASS DETAILS Non-resident rates will be charged unless Proof of Residency is provided. Re-entry into same session is only permitted with daily receipt. Children 11 and under must be supervised by a participant 16 years or older. One adult with every three children ages 5 and under required. All individuals entering the facility are required to pay an admission fee. All patrons that intend on using any pool are required to wear proper swim attire and may be asked to exit the pool if failure to comply.

For membership pass fees, the definition of "family" includes two spouses, or one parent and one adult guardian (maximum of 2 adults), and up to four single, legal, dependent children (under the age of 21) residing at the same address. PLEASE NOTE: After the fourth dependent, there is an additional fee of R-\$30/NR-\$40, per dependent. Additional adults are not included in the definition of a family, but are eligible for individual passes or daily admission fees.
