

Message from Mayor Craig A. Moe

On March 11, 2021, President Joseph R. Biden signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) which established the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund. These funds will be used to improve quality of life for Laurel residents, to provide for immediate community recovery needs, and to create a long-term investment for Laurel's future.

The U.S. Treasury has allocated \$21.4 million to the City of Laurel. The City expects to receive up to 50% (approximately \$10 million) of these funds in the coming weeks and the remaining balance approximately 12 months later. I am taking the necessary steps to get this much needed funding out into the community and to ensure that the City acts responsibly and equitably in expending these funds.

The Mayor and City Council intend to provide various options for public input opportunities to ensure all community voices are heard. As additional opportunities are scheduled, they will be promoted through City platforms and on this webpage.
