Rules & Regulations

- 1. Only <u>one table</u> will be provided per vendor application. Tables are limited and will be assigned to vendors based on application approval. Vendors may provide their own table or additional tables but may not expand outside of the designated assigned space or encroach on another designated vendor spot. Two chairs will be provided per space.
- 2. Spaces will be assigned by the Department of Parks & Recreation. The Department reserves the right to deny requests for space assignment.
- 3. Event set-up will be from 12:00-1:30pm. Vehicles will be permitted on the field (weather permitting) during set-up time but will be required to move to public street parking before the start of the event.
- 4. Event breakdown will begin promptly at 5:00pm. Vehicles may not enter the field space (weather permitting) until the area is clear of pedestrians and other event participants. Vehicles must clear the field space by 5:30pm.
- 5. All vendors are responsible for their designated area including setup, breakdown, proper disposal of trash and any recyclables. The City will not be held responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items brought to the event.
- 6. The City will not provide a canopy. All canopies must meet CPAI-84 and NFPA-701 Fire Resistant Requirements. Non-compliant canopies will be asked to be removed. Your canopy must be weighted down and properly secured in the event of windy conditions. (See attachment.)
- 7. Vendors may be asked to provide a Certificate of Insurance. Failure to provide proper documentation will result in denial of participation.
- 8. Handouts are permitted including flyers, pamphlets, business cards, and other similar marketing material. Food vendors must complete a Food Vendor Application and will be required to have a Mobile Food Vendor License issued by the City of Laurel Department of the Fire Marshall and Permit Services. (See attachment.)
- 9. The City of Laurel prohibits the following:
 - Use of or sale of alcohol, tobacco/vaping, firearms, or gambling as part of Special Events.
 - Use of live animals as part of any special event without specific approval.
 - Generators, fireworks/pyrotechnics, and amusements without specific approval.
 - Use of City of Laurel name, seal, logos, or likeness for use in advertisements without specific approval.
 - Distribution at events of profane or other material deemed inappropriate by City of Laurel Officials.
- 10. The City of Laurel Department of Parks & Recreation's Community and Culture Day is a community and family event, and vendors will be selected to participate as a reflection of this event. A vendor application may be denied or withdrawn by the City if a vendor's booth or actions are unlawful or inappropriate for the festival.
