Executive Order No. 2021-02

Subject: *Snow Emergency Declared*

Effective Date: January 30, 2021

Pursuant to the powers granted to the Mayor by Section 2-176 and 2-177 of the Laurel City Code, I, Mayor Craig A. Moe, hereby declare a State of Emergency in the City of Laurel effective at 6:00 pm on January 30, 2021 due to a winter storm that is expected to arrive on Sunday, January 31, 2021 and is expected to bring a possible accumulation of snow of up to six (6) inches in the City of Laurel. Among other things, the possibility exists that the City may have to eliminate or restrict parking on certain City streets designated as snow emergency routes and other areas that have been identified as critical locations. This Executive Order shall remain in effect until further notice or until it has been amended or rescinded.
