COVID-19


Effective Date: March 20, 2020

Pursuant to the powers granted to me by Section 2-176 and Section 2-177 of the Laurel City Code, I, Craig A. Moe, Mayor of the City of Laurel have declared a Municipal Civil Emergency in the City of Laurel due to an outbreak of disease (COVID-19) which does constitute an imminent threat to the health, safety and welfare of the City and its citizens.

The transmission of the novel CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) in the State, County and City continues to be a public health threat to the citizens, business community and visitors in the City of Laurel.

It is for that reason that I have designated all ***City of Laurel employees as Essential Personnel*** during this Public Health Emergency. This action is being taken in the City to keep the community safe, provide delivery of services and to assist with limiting the spread of the Coronavirus, COVID-19.

This Executive Order shall take effect Friday, March 20, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. and shall remain in effect until my further notice.
