It is the policy that all units of the Department cooperate between ranks and units.

A. GENERAL

1. All members are strictly charged with establishing and maintaining a high spirit of cooperation within the Department.

B. RESPECT TO SUPERIORS

1. Every member shall respect his/her commander, superior, or supervisor at all times and shall refrain from critical or derogatory comment on orders received from or issued by that person.

C. ADDRESSING SUPERIORS

1. Members shall observe a respectful attitude and use proper title when addressing their superiors, particularly in the presence of the public.

D. INFORMING SUPERIORS

1. Members shall inform superiors of any matter coming to their attention that may affect the welfare or interest of the Department or any other city service.
