1 / 118.05 GENERAL

Members of the Department shall be punctual in attendance to all calls, requirements of duty, appointments, and other assignments.

1 / 118.10 PERSONAL ACTIVITIES

An employee shall not play games, watch television or movies, or engage in any activity or personal business while on duty that would cause him / her to neglect or be inattentive to that duty.

1 / 118.15 FAILURE TO ACT

The failure of a police employee to take appropriate action, either on or off duty, on the occasion of a crime, disorder, or other condition deserving police or Department administrative attention will be considered neglect of duty.

1 / 118.20 ABSENCE

A police employee will not, without proper authorization, absent themselves from his / her assigned patrol during his / her tour of duty.

1 / 118.25 REMAINING ALERT

An employee will remain awake and alert while he / she is on duty. If unable to do so, he / she will so report to his / her supervisor, who will determine the proper course of action.
