**4 / 706.05 GENERAL**

As agency staffing permits, the department will permit the temporary rotating assignments of sworn personnel. Temporary rotational assignments will be limited to the Special Operations Division and Special Crimes Unit. This will afford officers the opportunity for individual growth as well as improved job satisfaction. These rotational assignments will provide officers insight into the job itself should future vacancies occur.

Temporary rotational assignments will not exceed 90 days in length unless authorized by the Chief of Police.

**4 / 706.10 SELECTION**

Officers interested in being assigned to the Special Operations Division for a temporary rotational assignment should submit a letter of interest to their respective Division Commander via their immediate supervisor. Only PFCs and officers not on probation will be considered. Applicants must have scored above satisfactory on their two most recent evaluations.

When a temporary rotational assignment is available, each officer must submit, in writing, a letter to the Commander of the Special Operations Division requesting the assignment. The Commander of Special Operations will interview each eligible officer before a selection is made.
