5 / 114.05 GENERAL

Whenever an officer receives a call that is routine in nature and is not directed to respond in a priority manner, they will obey all traffic laws when responding to the scene. The use of emergency equipment during routine response is prohibited.

5 / 114.10 RESPONSE TO ALARMS

All residential and commercial alarm calls within the City of Laurel will have two cars assigned for service. Unless the alarm is received as a “panic” alarm or reported as a Breaking and Entering, Robbery, or Hold-Up in progress, the response will be routine.
