

RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAY/PAVING/R-O-W

- Application for Work in the Public Right-of-Way
- 2- Site plans of property depicting location and size of proposed curb cut and/or parking pad
- 3- Sets of plans
- In Lieu of Bond form must be completed by Property Owner
- Paving permit (for parking pad)

Please note: If a curb cut AND apron exist and neither is going to be altered, a R-O-W permit is **not** required.

However, if a curb cut exists but there is currently no apron- a R-O-W permit **IS Required**. An apron is required for all driveways.
